ISA CERTIFIED ARBORIST®

requirements:

- Fulfill one of the following three training options:
 - 3 years experience in tree care **OR**
 - 2-year degree in arboriculture + 2 yrs. experience **OR**
 - 4-year degree in a related field + 1 yr experience
- Must apply for and pass a 200-question multiple-choice exam and pay the exam fee.
- You will need 30 CEUs in 3 years to recertify and must pay the recertification fee.

requirements:

- Must be an ISA Certified Arborist® in good standing
- Must have obtained a total of eight points from any or all of the four categories that include measurable experience, formal education, related credentials, or professional experience.
- You will need 60 CEUs (20 of each of the three domains) in 3 years to recertify and must pay the recertification fee.

requirements:

- Must have 18 months climbing experience
- Proof of CPR/first aid and aerial rescue training
- Must apply for and pass a 65-question multiple-choice exam as well as pass the skills exam
- To retain credential you must earn 15 CEUs, show valid proof of aerial rescue, CPR and first aid, as well as pay the recertification fee every 3 years

requirements:

- Must have 18 months climbing experience, at least 6 months' worth must be in the operation of an aerial lift device
- Proof of CPR/first aid and aerial rescue training
- Must apply for and pass a 65-question multiple-choice exam as well as pass the skills exam
- To retain credential you must earn 15 CEUs, show valid proof of aerial rescue, CPR and first aid, as well as pay the recertification fee every 3 years
