3. Ongoing service to the Chapter. Provide a detailed schedule of the person's service to ISAO such as serving on a committee, the ISAO Board and other volunteer or related service activities. "On-going" is meant as at least 4 to 6 years.

4. Valuable Service to the Chapter. Provide a detailed description on how the achievement(s) described in 1above and the ongoing service provided in 2 above constitute "valuable service" to the ISAO.
